## Each child

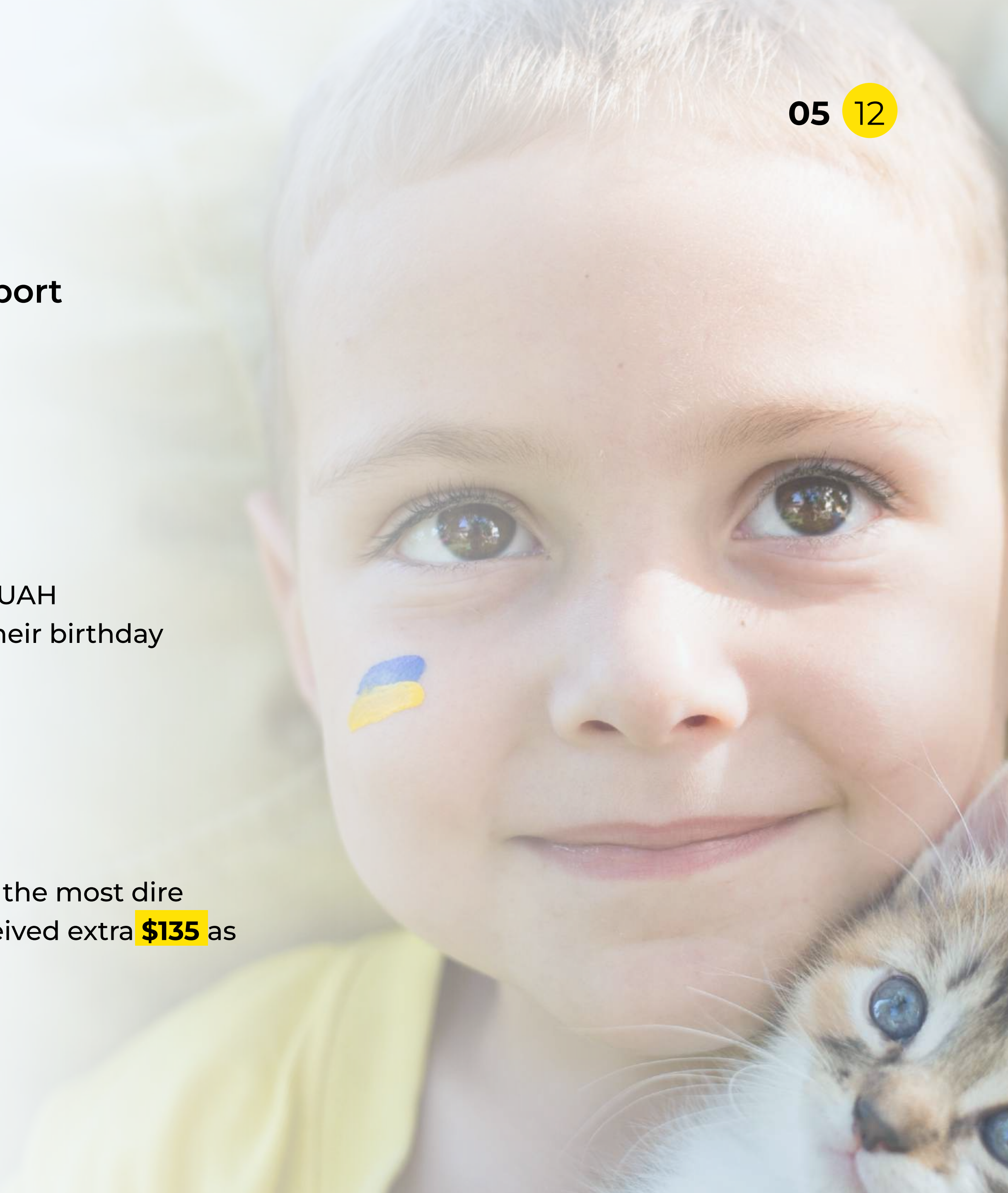
and their caregiver **receives 5,000 UAH (\$135 USD)** in immediate funding after completing their verification

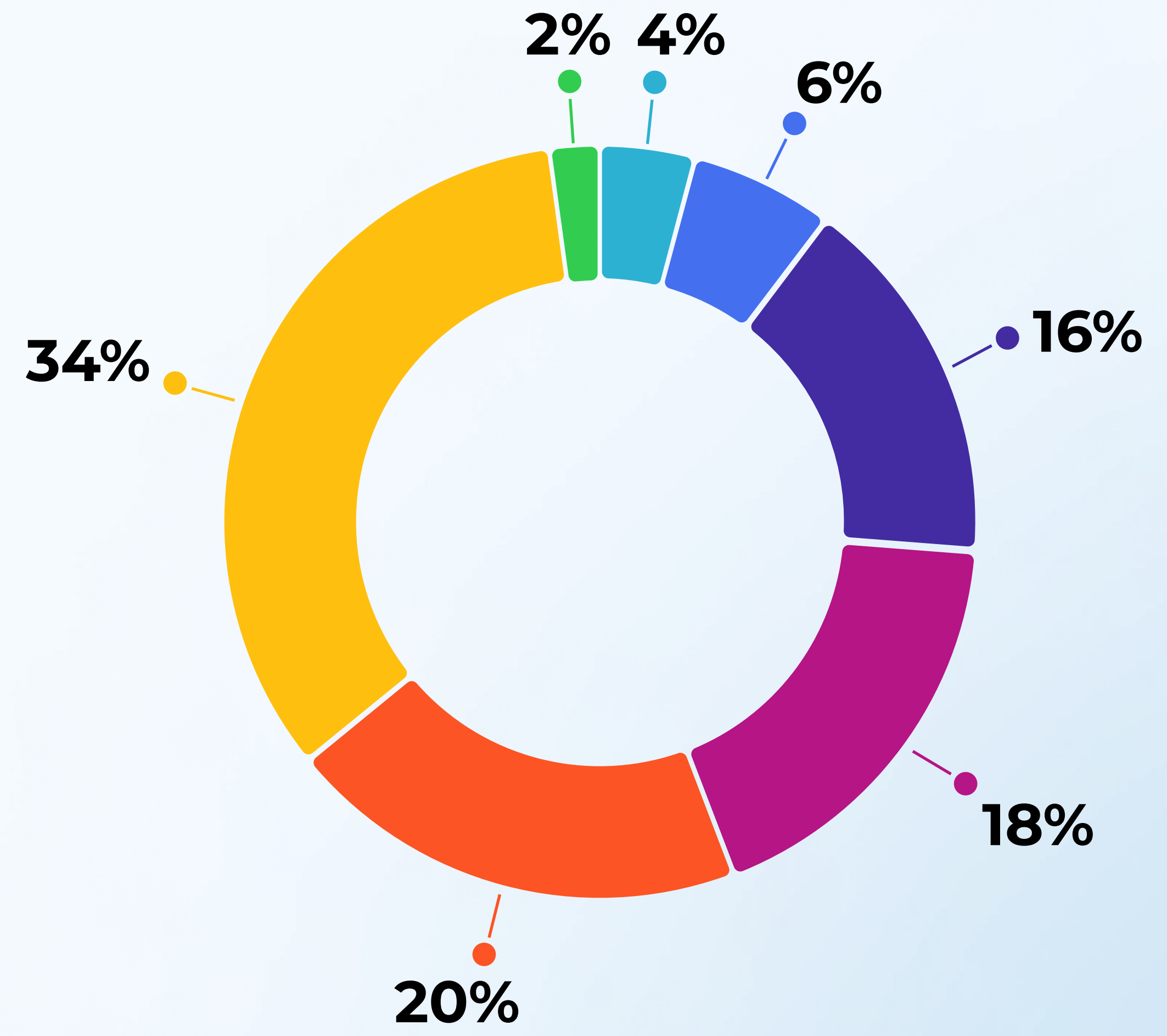
**As on February 1, the Fund's team consists of 68 people, 43 of which are working directly with the children**

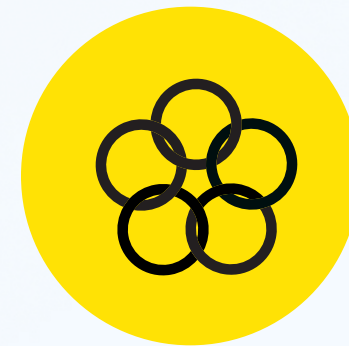

Evacuation / relocation of families from areas of active conflict



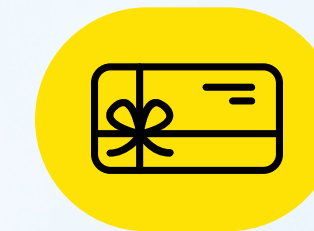

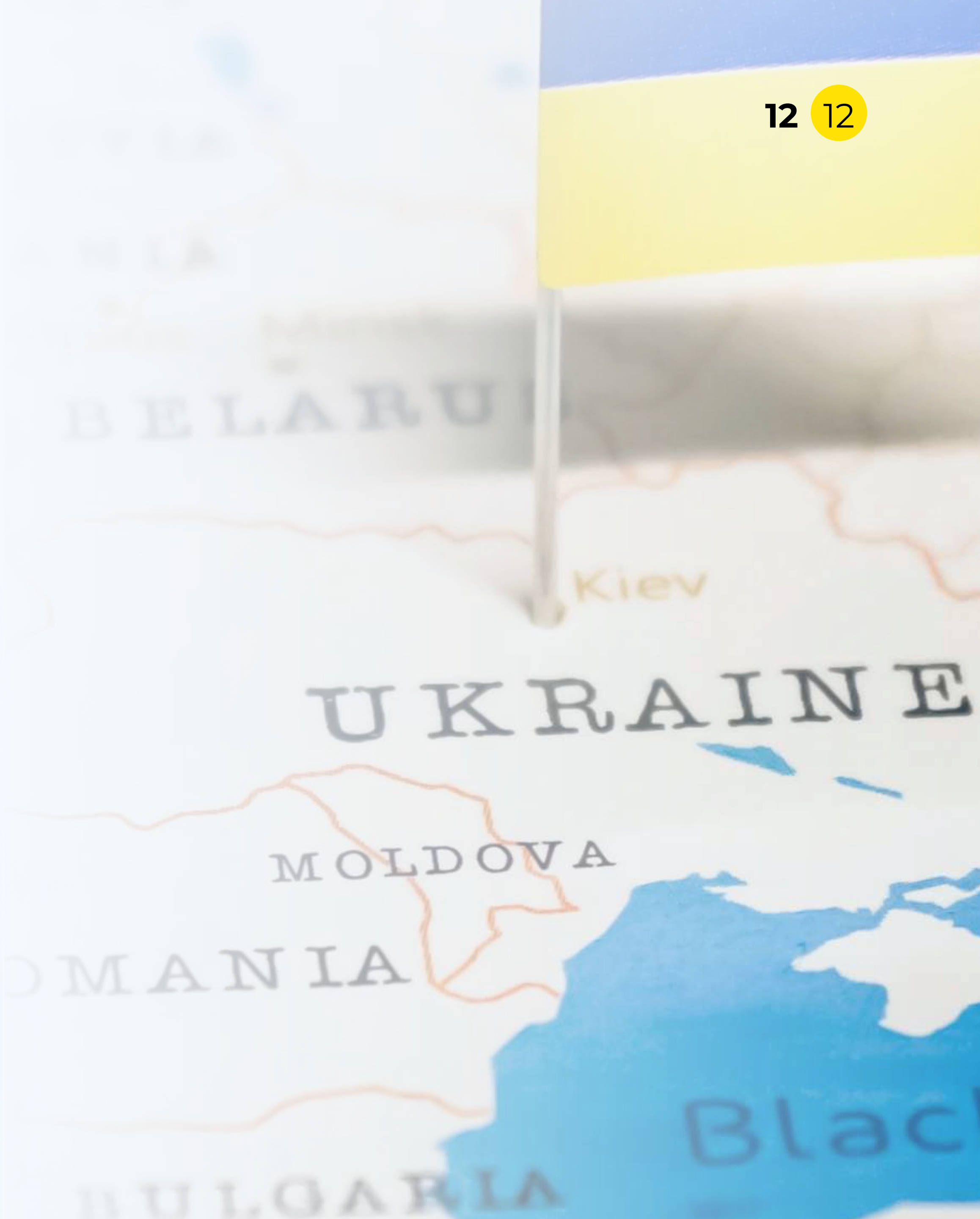
