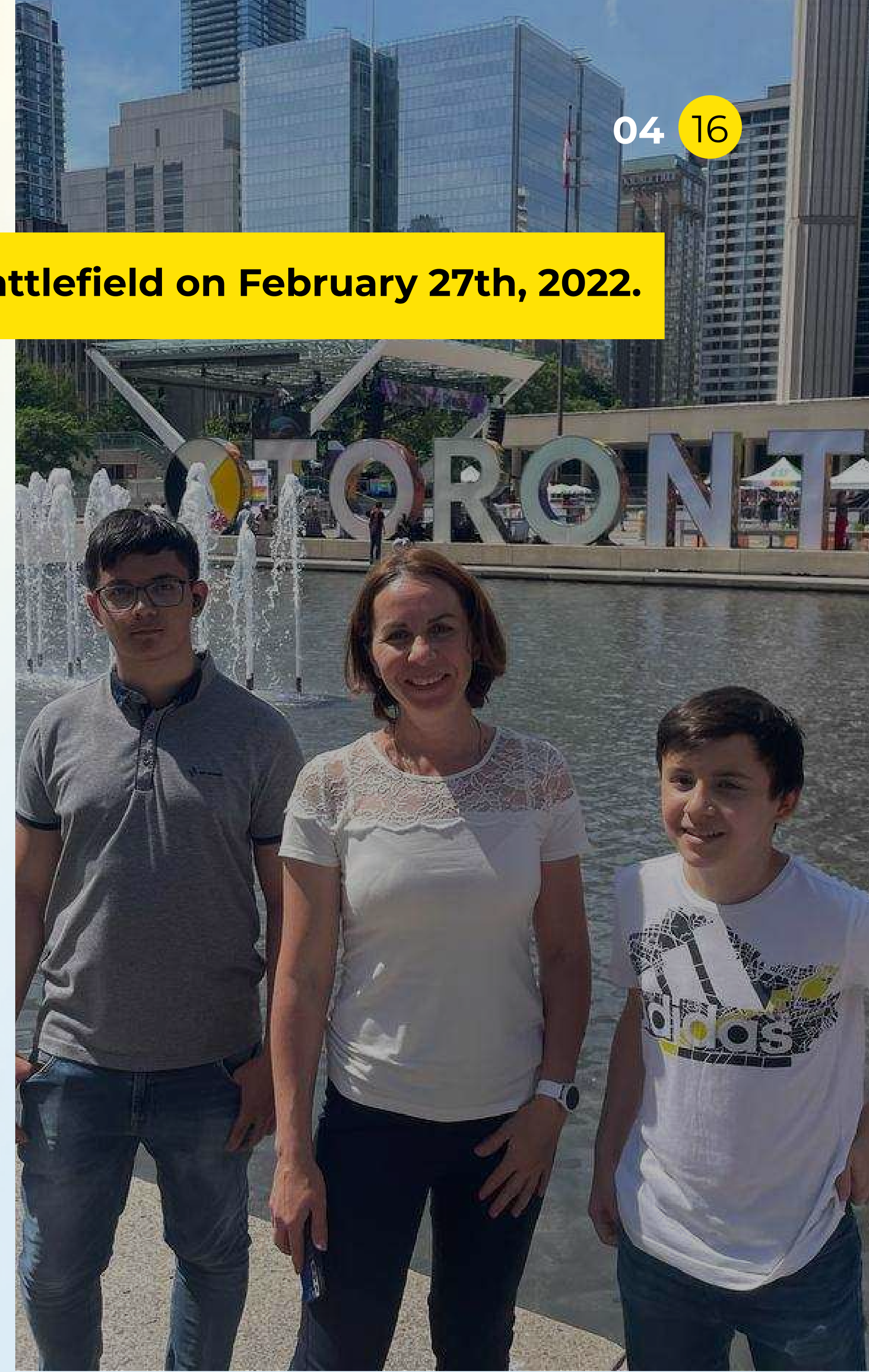
# Inspiring story of the month

**The father of Oleksandr and Artur Kutsenko (aged 16 and 12) died on the battlefield on February 27th, 2022.**

Their mother worked as a doctor in the town of Pology, Zaporizhzhia region in the southeast of Ukraine. Meanwhile, her husband was a soldier who heroically went to defend his homeland. Tragically, he died while defending Ukraine on February 27th, 2022. **Oleksandr and Artur miss their father dearly and constantly think about him.** The boys feel a never-ending sense of grief as it is very difficult for them to cope with the loss of their father. **The Kutsenko family lost all** of their belongings that they had acquired over their lifetime at the hands of the occupiers. A rocket flew into their home and the family's car was shot at by the Russian military. However, the most painful thing for them was the loss of a loved one, their husband and father, who cannot be brought back to life.

Thanks to the Children of Heroes fund, in collaboration with the organizers of Deeds4kids, Oleksandr and Artur's **fathers dream** for the boys to study in Canada **came true**. As of June, 2023, the family now lives in Toronto. **The Kutsenko family's longing for a peaceful life has finally become a reality** as the children settle into their new surroundings in the city and have received the opportunity to study, live and work there.





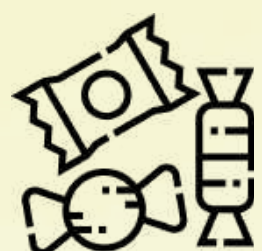
